1 **JUDGMENT**


2 1. The Court hereby enters final judgment in this Action in accordance with terms of the  
3 Stipulation and Settlement of Class Action and Private Attorneys General Act Representative Claims  
4 (the "Agreement" or "Settlement"), order granting preliminary approval of class action settlement  
5 ("Procedural Order"), and the final order approving class action settlement ("Final Order").

6 2. Upon full and final payment by Defendant St. Joseph Health Northern California  
7 d.b.a. St. Joseph Hospital - Eureka ("Defendant") of the Class Settlement Amount and the  
8 employer's share of payroll taxes consistent with Paragraph H of the Settlement, Plaintiff/Class  
9 Representative and all Class Members who did not affirmatively opt out of the Settlement  
10 Agreement by submitting a timely and valid Request for Exclusion shall have, by operation of the  
11 Final Order and this Judgment, fully, finally and forever released, relinquished, and discharged the  
12 Releasees from the Released Claims, and the Plaintiff's Released Claims, as those terms are  
13 respectively defined in the Settlement, and are hereby forever barred and enjoined from prosecuting  
14 such released claims against the Released Parties.

15 3. The following persons have timely requested exclusion from the Settlement and are  
16 not bound by this judgment: Irene Funk, Denys Goozee, Jennifer Lloyd, Morgan Valente, and Lori  
17 Weller.

18 4. Without affecting the finality of the Final Order and/or this Judgment, pursuant to  
19 California Code of Civil Procedure Section 664.6 and Rule 3.769(h) of the California Rules of  
20 Court, the Court reserves exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over this Action, Plaintiff, settling  
21 Class Members, and Defendant for the purposes of supervising the implementation, enforcement,  
22 construction, and interpretation of the Settlement, the Procedural Order, the Final Order, and the  
23 Judgment.
