PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on March 2, 2023 at 8:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard in Department 17 of the above-entitled Court located at 1415 Truxton Avenue, Bakersfield, California 93301, Plaintiff Stacie Horton ("Plaintiff") will and hereby does move this Court for an Order:

- 1. Granting preliminary approval of the proposed Joint Stipulation of Settlement ("Settlement Agreement");
- 2. Conditionally certifying the proposed Class for settlement purposes only;
- 3. Appointing Plaintiff Stacie Horton as the Class Representative;
- 4. Appointing Aegis Law Firm, PC as Class Counsel;
